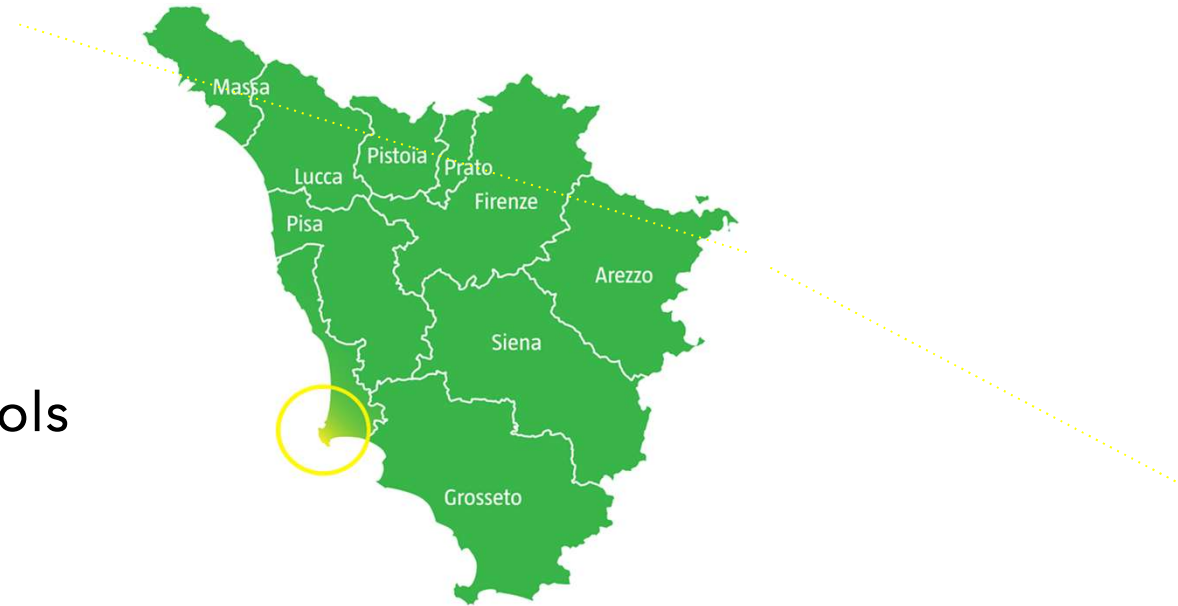

THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM OF THE POPULONIA TERRITORY (Piombino)



Situated in the old town of Piombino, facing the sea, the museum preserves more than 2000 archaeological finds that tell the history of the ancient Populonia and obtained the recognition as “Museum of Regional Relevance”.

The museum make use of modern devices to tell the ancient history:

- Interactive installation to discover the "Sounds of the Past"
- A multimedia itinerary with reconstructed models of the three symbols of the ancient Populonia: the Chariot Tomb, the Fish Mosaic, and the Silver Amphora of Baratti.

LITTLE MUSEUMS IN THE HISTORIC VILLAGE OF CAMPIGLIA MARITTIMA

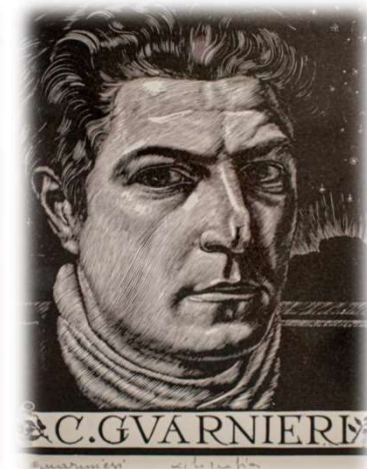
Campiglia Marittima, a Medieval village surrounded by hills and the sea, in 2022 obtained the recognition as one of the "Most beautiful villages in Italy".

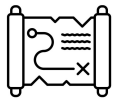

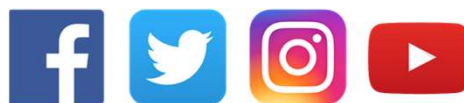
